### Qualifications for this position:

- High School diploma/GED required
- Education or experience with school age children is preferable

### Requirements:

- Must be able to withstand exposure to all types of weather
- Must be able to swim and/or safely enter pool and supervise students
- Demonstrate ability to supervise students (observe, listen, assess, react) as needed to ensure a safe environment
- Demonstrate good attendance and punctuality
- Demonstrate good communication skills (verbal and written). Be able to effectively communicate with co-workers, children's parents or guardians about daily activities, behaviors, and related issues. Therefore, proficiency of the English language is required including the meaning and spelling of words, rules of composition, and grammar.
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is required to stand, walk, sit, reach with hands and arms, stoop, climb or balance, kneel, crouch, or crawl, talk, hear (in a quiet or noisy environment). The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 40 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision and ability to adjust/focus.
